Dear Members of the Presidio Trust Board,

We, the undersigned residents of the Pilots' Row and Fort Scott neighborhoods, are writing to express our support for the Presidio Exchange project. Each of the three finalists is a worthy project that deserves a home in the Bay Area; however, we believe the Presidio Exchange is the best fit on the former Presidio Commissary site.

We found the rationale presented by Greg Moore, Executive Director of the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy, in the public meetings and in the on-line presentations of the PX project to be wholly persuasive. The PX proposal provides the clearest connection between the site and the vision and programming of both the Presidio Trust and the GGNRA, creating a new public place designed to provide broad benefits for visitors to the parks.

In our unique role as residents at the end of the Golden Gate Bridge in the Presidio, we have daily interactions with visitors who are lost or wondering about programs and sites within the Park. How wonderful it would be to point to the PX as their hub. People have needed a place to gather indoors (to be out of the weather but still enjoy the vistas), and to learn about the many opportunities in the Presidio and GGNRA.

Many residents of San Francisco (and, indeed, of the Presidio itself) are unaware of the jurisdictional divisions between the Presidio and the GGNRA. Whatever the value might be of clarifying these distinctions in certain situations, we believe a greater good would be served in this case by emphasizing their shared mission as adjoining national parks.

The PX project would be a remarkable addition to the growing number of educational and cultural resources along Crissy Field. It would stand out as a testament to the willingness of the Presidio and the GGNRA to work together for the benefit of the American public and visitors to our parks from around the world.
